educating the urban poor. Following the success of Cristo Rey Jesuit High School—which opened its doors in 1996 and became a national model by providing a Catholic college prep education for inner-city families at or near the poverty level—this fall the Chicago Province opened Chicago Jesuit Academy, a Nativity-model middle school (grades 5–8) serving the poor of Chicago’s West Side.
