## *A School in Nairobi*

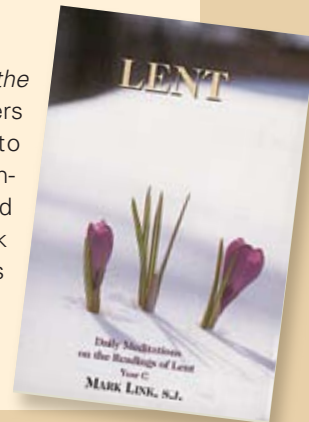
